

Coller Research Fellowship Use Guidelines

The award should be used to promote conduct of a specified research project by paying for goods or services that are consumed in acquisition of data.

1. Payment of resident salary expenses, direct salary or benefits, would not be permitted
2. Payment of facility rent not permitted.
3. Payment of indirect costs not permitted.
4. Payment for consumables such as animals, reagents, lab supplies, database acquisition or database use fees all permitted. Detailed budget required to validate the nature, amount and price of consumables to assure expenditures are reasonable for what is purchased and that the materiel is applicable to the project which has been approved.
5. Fees for work done within scientific cores (ie DNA sequencing, flow cytometry, electron microscopy etc.) permitted. Budget required.
6. Salary of technical help or fees for technical work done in cores permitted. Budget required.
7. Publication expenses allowed.
8. Travel to professional meetings for presentation of results permitted if the Coller scholar is first author on work being presented. No travel outside of US permitted. No travel expenses permitted if Coller scholar not first author.
9. Educational or surgical aids that will become the property of the scholar (textbooks, subscriptions, computers, laptops, tablets, loupes, etc.) not permitted.
